Minutes of the April 14, 2010 meeting were unanimously adopted on a motion by J. Portley/ J. Bodwell.

Item #2

J. Rode presented the updated list of project priorities for the STP-Urban and ARRA programs. ARRA has been fully obligated the balance of funds will be used for project 100-175 Universal Drive Pavement Preservation. The Urban program saw 6 projects added to FFY10 which assures the funds are fully allocated. These projects are # 59-152 Drainage & Roadway Rte146, # 59-158 Stepstone Hill Rd Pavement Preservation, 92-561 State Street Bridge, #100-175 Sacket Point Road Bridge Replacement, #100-176 Universal Drive Pavement Preservation, and #156-XXX1 Campbell Ave Pavement Preservation. S. Dudley spoke about the projects in particular about #59-152 which is a project on a state highway added at the request of ConnDOT. He also spoke about a request from New Haven to include, in the STP-Urban program, a project for the replacement of the Grand Ave Bridge.
